WHAT DO I BRING TO CAMP?

Every day campers should bring the twilight camp essentials in a small backpack or daybag: reusable water bottle filled with water, A dinner (packed in a bag or lunch box), a snack and extra sunscreen. PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING YOU BRING TO CAMP.

This fun option is for adult volunteers' non-scout children who need supervision while they are volunteering at twilight camp. One daily snack and drinking water will be provided, along with age appropriate activities in indoor and outdoor play areas. Children can only attend while their parent/guardian is on-site. Parent must check-out child if they leave twilight camp for any reason. Volunteers must attend to the toileting, changing and/or first aid needs of their children.

TOILET TRAINED CHILDREN ONLY. Ages 4 and up is recommended due to full schedule and the need for parents to attend to any toileting or first aid needs for their children.
