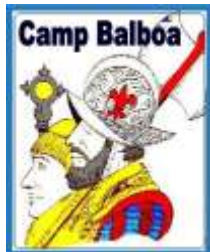


2010 Summer Camp – Schedule & Fees

BOY SCOUT RESIDENT SUMMER CAMP

Boy Scout Resident Summer Camp is what each Boy Scout Troop aims to do each summer. Spend an entire week camping, earning merit badges and learning Scouting Skills. There are also lots of opportunities for adult leader training while the boys have fun. San Diego-Imperial Council operates two Boy Scout Resident Summer Camps: Camp Fiesta Island and Mataguay Scout Ranch.

Camp Fiesta Island

Camp Fiesta Island is located on Mission Bay at 1750 Fiesta Island Road. Campers have opportunities to spend time on the water in the vast aquatics program and advancement opportunities. Camp Fiesta Island fills very quickly due to the limited enrollment, so plan to make your reservations early. Sessions and fees for 2010 are as follows:

Mataguay Scout Ranch

Mataguay Scout Ranch is located in the backcountry of San Diego County near Warner Springs. Campers have numerous opportunities for fun and advancement. Sessions and fees are as follows:

Webelos Resident Camp at Mataguay Scout Ranch: Monday June 21 – Friday June 25
Youth (in Council) \$240, Youth (out of Council) \$250, Adult \$100 (one free adult with 6 Cubs if paid in full by 5-31-10)
