

## Frequently asked questions- (many from the Leader's Zoom meeting)

Q. Do you accept swim checks form outside of camp

A. We do if using the approved new BSA form <https://www.scouting.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/03/Swim-Classificaiton-record-430-122.pdf>

However, be aware that the bay is different than a pool and safety is our first concern.

Q. Can non swimmers use the waterfront?

A. We will have a non-swimmer area marked per BSA guidelines to be not more than chest deep. Non swimmers may go in a canoe or kayak with an adult swimmer. Must have a buddy tag from arrival day.

Q. Do we need to sleep in individual tents?

A. All Troops/ Scouts must provide their own tent. Provisional Scouts will sleep in their own tent unless attending with a Scout from their home unit and the parents are in agreement. Troops and parents will need to decide how their Troop camps -single or with Tent buddies.

Q. What uniform should Scouts wear upon arrival?

A. Depending how far you are travelling. It is suggested that you be comfortable, if possible, wear swim suit to make changing for swim check easier. Your charter organization and Troop leadership can set what to wear while traveling. There is NO BSA requirement to travel in uniform. Uniform is not required until flags and Dinner on Sunday evening. Day Trekkers should arrive in clothes comfortable for the Day. A Scout T-shirt is acceptable.

Q. Day Trekker Questions

A. Day Trekkers will receive a separate Welcome email.

Q. AB506 questions

A. All CA adult leaders must be registered, YPT, and AB506 compliant. If your Council has not set up the live scan prior to your arrival, the online training must be self-documented. All non-CA adults must be BSA registered adult in their home council.

Q. Wednesday Activities and COVID

A. If we find that excursions/field trips do not align with current County Health department guidelines. We will plan a fun day on the beach at camp.

Q. Wednesday activities Sign -up questions

A. Still working with the transportation vendor to then give you accurate pricing. Week one may not have as much time as other weeks. We will let you know a day in advance of opening to allow for someone to be available to register your group.

Q. Do you require negative COVID-19 test prior to arriva?

A. No. We will expect you an your unit to do the [BSA event pre-screening checklist](#) prior to brining any Scout in your group.

Q. Will you send a Scout home if exposed to COVID-19 or shows symptoms.

A. We will follow the current CDC guidelines for quarantine/isolation. The extreme is that a Scout test positive or was exposed and is not vaccinated, he/she must be quarantined, which may involve sending home.

Q. What about the Dining Hall area Covid-19 precautions?

A. We will require every person in the self-serve Buffet line to wash with soap and water prior to getting in line and to wear a mask while going thru the buffet line. These are the CDC recommendations for a self-serve buffet line.
